The purpose of the Public Information Centre is update ratepayers about the Township of Algonquin Highlands' proposed system for managing hauled sewage within the municipality. This meeting will be the third in a series of public events hosted by the municipality, as part of the Class Environmental Assessment initiated by the Municipality in April 2004, under the Environmental Assessment Act.

The selection criteria used to identify a preferred alternative for the municipality will be outlined at the meeting and the preferred alternative will be introduced for consideration by the public.
